Thought for the week



LLOVE THE SMELL OF CHOLENT IN THE MORNING

It is very difficult to accurately convey with words the aroma which greeted me in shule this (Thursday) morning, with eight different cholents bubbling nicely in preparation for tonight's Cholent Fest! Now I'm really looking forward to tasting the Cholents (and salt beef, craft beer and chocolate) tonight, but I'm also enjoying the smell of it now. And here is the reason why:

The Jewish people arrive at Mt Sinai and receive the Torah in this week's sidra – it's the key event, it makes us who we are as a people, and yet we read something very interesting about this experience in the Pesach Haggadah.

We sing the famous song Dayenu, and the lyrics include the phrase "If You would have brought us to Mt Sinai, and not given

us the Torah – Dayenu (it would have been enough)". Now surely, the whole reason that G-d took us out of Egypt was to give us the Torah! How could it have "been enough" to arrive at Mt Sinai and not get the Torah? The parable used to explain this is that if you walk into a perfume store, you leave with a good smell even if you don't buy anything.

Similarly, the Jewish people would have been uplifted enough by reaching the point of Sinai that the "smell"- the experience would have left them a changed people even if they hadn't received the Torah, and for this too we must also be thankful.

So it's good to appreciate the smell of the cholent, even before you get a chance to taste it!
