Thought for the Week



Eternal Monuments

And Jacob set up a monument on her grave. This is the monument that is on Rachel's grave to this very day."
(Bereishit 35:20)

It is much better, writes the Chofetz Chaim, to provide a simple tombstone and to use the extra resources to provide for ongoing acts of charity, kindness and Torah study. This might be the provision of a gemillut chessed fund – ie an interest-free loan fund, set up in the name of the niftar (departed); each time the money is loaned to help someone in need, another mitzvah accrues to the soul of the departed. Alternatively, it could be the provision of books to a shule or Bet HaMedrash, inscribed with the name of the departed; each time Torah is studied from these books, another merit is

associated with the person who has died.

The saintly Rabbi Yisrael Meir Kagan (d. 1933), known as the Chofetz Chaim for his compendium on the laws of correct speech and the avoidance of lashon hara, also wrote a guide to the laws of kindness and charity. In it (2:25) he mentions that, whilst the setting up of a tombstone for someone who has died is a hallowed and honoured practice, which is derived from this week's Sedrah, a person should think carefully as to how he is allocating his resources. To spend an extravagant amount of money on a lavish tombstone is ultimately short-sighted. The dead do not need it: they are in a place where physical objects have no significance.

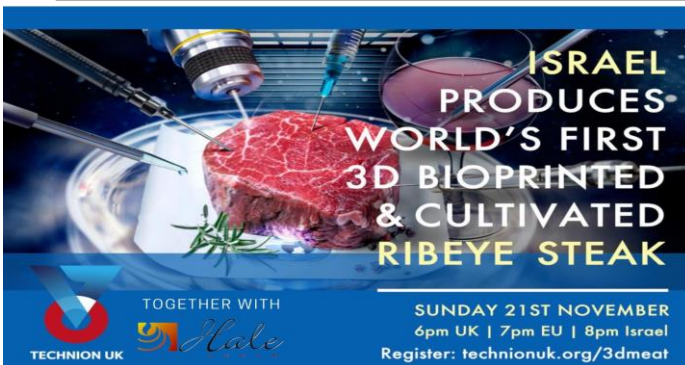

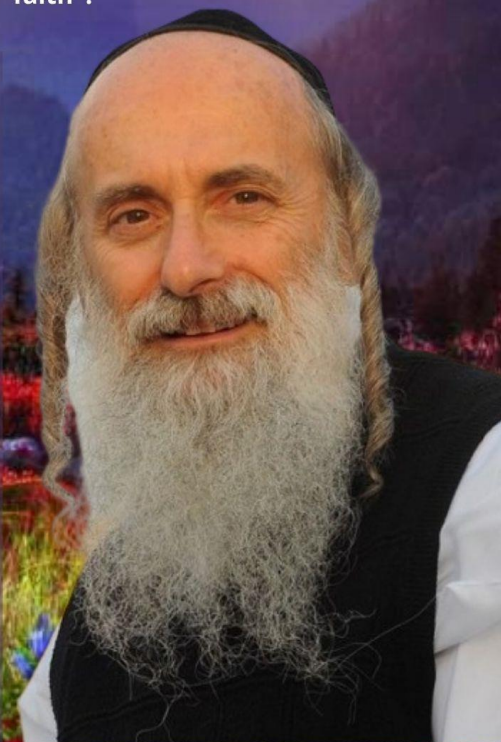
