Thought for the Week



LITTLE OR LOT?

What type of person was Lot, the nephew of Abraham? He is the son of Abraham's brother, Haran, and he joins Abraham in leaving Ur and Charan on a journey to an unknown land. Our Sages point out that it is to Lot's credit that when Abram tells the Egyptian border officials that Sarai is his sister, Lot does not spill the beans. Yet, Lot's shepherds could not coexist amicably with the shepherds of Abram when they leave Egypt as wealthy men, and one can only assume that they took their lead from their Master. Lot's choice of the fertile but decadent area of Sodom as his preferred neighbourhood, tells us much about his wish to distance himself from his "frum" uncle

Lot rises to prominence in Sodom. According to the Midrash he even becomes a Judge. When Sodom and the other city states of the Dead Sea basin lose their battle in their rebellion against Cherdolo'omer, Lot is captured. It could well be that he was deliberately targeted so as to draw Abram into the conflict

Against all odds Abram defeats a much superior army and rescues Lot, who shows his gratitude to Uncle Abraham by returning to live in Sodom! In next week's sedra we read of Lot's hospitality, his rescue from Sodom by the angels, and his incest. Yet his descendant is Ruth the Moabite, the ancestor of King David and the Messiah. Unlike Abraham who is on a clear path of

Unlike Abraham who is on a clear path of righteousness throughout his life, rising in stature with each trial that is presented to him, Lot represents the potential of ordinary people to fall, or to achieve great things.

The multiple meanings of the Hebrew, vl, allude to this idea. Lot can mean mystery (I Samuel 18:22); cover (Isaiah 25:7); curse or spell (Shemot 8:14); and spice or lotus (Bereishit 37:5). Our potential is all too often hidden. Sometimes we can get it badly wrong and become a curse to ourselves and others. Yet there is, within all of us, the capacity to bring fragrant blessing to ourselves and our world.
